Format Abstract / Full Paper Template

Each article should include an informative, comprehensive abstract not exceeding 200 words. The format of abstract should provide the purpose, design/ methodology/ approach, findings, originality/value, a maximum of six keywords. For article in Bahasa Melayu/ Indonesia, the abstract must be written in Bahasa Melayu/ Indonesia and English.

Full papers should be written in Bahasa Melayu/ Indonesia or English. Manuscript should be typed with 1.5 line spacing in Microsoft Word 97 or higher and should not exceed 6,000 words. All texts should be left justified, typed using Times New Roman (size 12). The title should be printed in title case, font size 14 and center aligned. Tables and figures should be also center aligned.

References to other publications must be in *American Psychological Association* (*APA*) referencing style and references should be carefully checked for completeness, accuracy and consistency. Samples of entries are as follow:
